There is some molecular anthropological evidence for intermarriage amongst Siberian population groups. Linguistic investigations find evidence for language contact through loanwords and structural borrowings. Could Social Anthropology identify past contacts between populations? The analysis of the data among Even (clan's names, geographical positions, demography, economies, languages, rules of marriage, kinship terminologies of regional groups), informs us about the contacts between regional groups and neighbouring peoples, about conditions of economic and cultural shifts. New developments should follow.
